Well here we are at the end of another year where our planned theatre programme was interrupted by Covid 19 and a number of shows were either cancelled or moved to 2022. It was very difficult to prepare a programme but hopefully 2022 will benefit from these forced changes.

- "Come From Away" was brilliant and we thoroughly enjoyed the opening performance of the second part of this show. I received many emails thanking me for persevering with this show and it was really brilliant. 42 Members formed our party.
- Nothing more until the Christmas Show on the 15th December at Glen Street "Celebrate its Christmas". Again a good response with 52 tickets sold. Ian Stenlake has been chosen as the star performer this year

Saturday 19th February is our first show of 2022 when the "Australian and American Bandstand" celebrating the iconic hits and Music Legends that appeared in the 50's 60's and 70's.

Our original booking has sold out, however Glen Street has advised that they still have other seats available. If interested I can arrange tickets for you, please make your payment of \$59.90 by EFT to the Club.

- Monday the 14th March 11.00am we get the opportunity to see a Mini Moulin Spectacular "Le New Paris Skies" being a follow up from the show we saw and loved in March 2021 starring Milko Foucault - Larche and Corinne Andrew. Their show in 2021 was judged by our large audience to be the best morning show of the year. Tickets cost \$30.00 each and can he reserved.
- Although we were told that the Wharf Revue was finishing after last year, this is now not the case and the Wharf Revue: Can of Worms is returning to Glen Street and we have booked a performance. for Thursday 24th March at 8.00pm Tickets cost \$75.00 and already 36 have been sold. If interested please reserve tickets again by EFT to ensure your bookings.

- Friday 22nd April at last we will see The Everly Brothers & the Rock 'N' Roll Legends of the 50's and 60's. 48 members transferred from last year and other seats are available at \$59.90 each
- If I receive enough interest we might book "My Fair Laddies" the Lerner and Loewe Songbook transferred from last year and starring the Glen Street Theatre Favourite Glenn Amer together with Alison Claire Robertson. Tickets are again \$30.00 each and the performance is Monday 4th April at 11.00am
- Lastly after 2 years the show 9 5 is returning to Sydney at the Capitol Theatre on 4th May at 1.00pm. Tickets are \$69.50 each and already some booking have been made. Ring early as I think 31 tickets is the maximum we can get.

So that's the start of the year. We will look to book the Ensemble Theatre Production of "Black Cockatoo" cost \$67.50 from the 11th - 15th May and also Jane Eyre by Charlotte Bronte from the 25th - 29th May also costing \$67.50.
