General Business:

The President advised the meeting that the Uniting Church, where we have met since 2018, is to close early in September and we will have to move.

An exhaustive search has been undertaken by Peter Moxham and a number of other committee members to find an alternative venue to the church and the Forest Hotel "stood out" as the obvious choice due to its many advantages (no steps, plenty of parking, room for over 100 people etc). In addition two other local Probus Clubs are meeting there. The hotel will provide morning tea and several members have vouched for the quality of the senior's \$15 lunch for those who would like to stay on after the meeting.

The President thanked Peter and his team for all the time and effort they put in to lock in our new venue. In addition she also thanked all of our members who had worked in room setup over our years at the Church and also the great work that the morning tea groups had done to make our stay more pleasant and sociable.

Our Treasurer Colin Fordred then outlined the financial implications of our move. The Forest Hotel will charge us \$6 per head per meeting. This covers tea or coffee plus a cake for each member attending and includes use of the facilities.

Estimated Cost of General Meetings – September to December 2023

Hotel Charge \$ 2,520 (assumes 105 attending @\$6 ph)
Less Savings \$ 620 (Church hire plus morning tea costs)

Estimated reduction in accumulated funds \$1,900

Over a full year our General Meeting costs will increase by around \$5,600. As a result it may be necessary to increase our annual subscriptions. This will be discussed by the committee and put to the next AGM in March 2024.

Starting with our next meeting on 14 September we will meet at the Forest Hotel at 5 Frenchs Forest Road East, Frenchs Forest at 10am.
